

Elementary School Assessment

Students applying for enrollment in the Elementary school are assessed for their instructional levels in Reading, Writing, and Mathematics.

The assessment time requires:

- Grades 1 and 2 (30 minutes -1 hour)
- Grades 3 thru 5 (1 ½ to 2 hours)

Criteria for Admission into the Elementary School

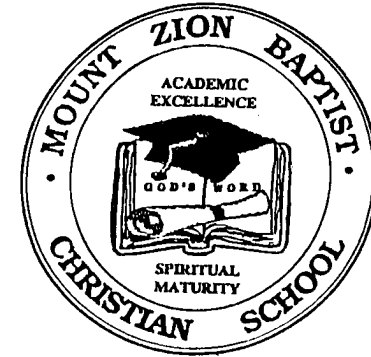
- A. Student completes the Reading, Writing and Math assessments and demonstrates an instructional level that is at least grade level.
- B. Student has a satisfactory conduct history that meets school standards.
- C. Student is willing to put forth good effort to learn and cooperate.
- D. Parents or Guardians agree to cooperate with the Parent Agreement, school policies, the staff and the basic teachings of the Christian faith.

In the Parent Agreement, parents agree:

1. to cooperate with the basic teachings of the Bible and our Christian faith.
2. to pray with their child and regularly attend a Bible teaching church.
3. to make timely tuition payments.
4. to work in partnership with your child's teacher to help support his or her growth and to cooperate with the school's policies.

When your child comes for the assessment, parents will receive a letter with an appointment day and time to meet and discuss the assessment results, school information and steps for registration.
